- 1. <u>Communications</u>:
 - a. We were excited to have had 118 of you sign up to receive these updates for 2024!
 - b. In addition to those who opted-in, we include:
 - Various Department Officials;
 - Department Vice Commanders;
 - District Commanders;
 - Some Department HQ staff;
 - Some members of Americanism Commission;
 - TALDF Board; and
 - TXBS Executive Committee.
 - c. <u>We defer to Commanders/hubmasters to further share/distribute these updates, if desired</u>.
- 2. <u>Thank you</u>, always, for what you do at the Posts/locally—always key to finding the very best talent!
- 3. Our dates of <u>9-14 June 2024</u> are confirmed with UT Austin for our program.
- 4. <u>1 May 2024</u> is our <u>registration deadline</u>, please. Thank you for planning forward to help us here. The logistics complexity, UT requirements, and all sorts of new factors to execute this program seem to multiply every year.
- 5. A few notes from the 2023 National Boys State Director's Conference:
 - 34% of Boys State programs shrank last year across the country, and 100% are below overall Department averages since inception.
 - Engaging students is becoming more challenging as Post membership shrinks and key Post members pass and roles not backfilled.
 - A number of states are already doing integrated (male/female) programs (CT, MA, MO), with some doing so because required by legislation (California).
 - Given American Legion fundraising restrictions, and the challenges noted above and more, states have started to create entirely separate legal entities from AL Departments in order to build for the future.
 - Plus we gathered a number of other great innovations, techniques, and practices from other programs which we are evaluating to help keep our program absolutely premier in the Nation.
- 6. Please see the attached flyer, used in recruiting efforts into areas of Texas where there is no TXBS representation (you are free to use if helpful).

- 7. Our 2024 Brochure and Fact sheet are being revised, along with the website. We will report to you when all is fully updated.
- 8. As you are likely aware, there is a new(ish) American Legion logo.
 - a. We are required to now integrate the logo into our Texas Boys State paraphernalia.
 - b. While in transition, we will (of course) use the shirts we already have in inventory, in addition to ordering shirts that will incorporate the new logo (design TBD).
 - c. It is possible your 2024 Statesmen will have some combination of old logo and new logo shirts while we make the shift.

 - a. Friday, 14 June 2024.
 - b. We would love as many "Legion Hats" to represent to the about 1,800+ people we'll touch that day.
 - c. More to follow next year.
- 10. Thank you to our <u>Sons of the American Legion</u> who have kindly offered their assistance this year with some important initiatives. So grateful! More info later.
- 11. Our goal remains to have <u>1,000 Statesmen this year</u> (this is also our planning factor on the budget)—so, thank you for doing everything in your power to help.
 - a. In addition to your local efforts, we have had a dedicated team working to maximize viz of your program.
 - b. Huge thank you to Lucas Turner and Alex Rose for sending <u>over 2,000 emails</u> in the last few weeks to schools where there has been zero TXBS representation!
 - c. Last year, we had 20 Statesmen from schools that sent Statemen for the first time ever. We are looking to hit at least 90 this year of entirely new schools (including from underrepresented areas).
 - d. We cannot express enough our thanks for the volunteer efforts of the people that bleed into this program, in addition to their normal work and family lives . . . like Lucas and Alex.
